The number of 'live' recitals in City churches is increasing and this is an encouraging sign of a return to a kind of 'normal' for the Square Mile. As one scans the listings the names of certain composers whose works are to be performed 'catch the eye'. For your editor this most certainly applied to the listing for a concert taking place at **St Mary le Bow** on Friday 17th September at 7.00pm. The names of three composers are quoted in the display on page 23 below and your editor confesses that the only one known to him is that of Handel. The other two are James Oswald and Thomas Erskine who were apparently contemporaries of George Frederic Handel. James Oswald was born in Crail, Scotland in 1710. As a young man he worked in Dunfermline, Fife as a musician and dancing master. Throughout his career he maintained an interest in traditional Scottish music, but he also composed in classical *style galant* forms. *Style galant* is described a clear, elegant, uncomplicated style that arose in Germany in the 18th century in contrast to the more complex style of Baroque counterpoint. It is light, graceful, sometimes witty, and very pleasing to listen to. The term *style galant* is also applied to the visual arts and literature.

In 1741 James Oswald left Edinburgh, eloping to London with Mary Ann Melvill whom he married in 1741 in St James's Piccadilly. This exodus to London is the theme of the concert at St Mary le Bow as its title conveys – 'From Caledonia to the Capital'. In London Oswald eventually set up his own publishing house and published the *Caledonian Pocket Companion*, a collection of Scottish folk tunes, some with his own variations. This ran to 12 volumes and many editions. Like many others he was a member of "The Temple of Apollo", a secret musical society of composers in London along with Thomas Erskine, 6th Earl of Kellie and others. Erskine was an eccentric Scottish musician whose considerable talent as a virtuoso violinist (which earned him the sobriquet 'Fiddler Tam') and as a composer brought him international fame and his rakish habits notoriety, but nowadays is little known. Apparently in recent times his compositions have led to him being re-evaluated as one of the most important British composers of the 18th century, as well as a leading exponent of Scotland's music. His String Symphony features in the concert at St Mary le Bow. Also in the concert vocal music from Oswald's rarely performed song collections will be performed together with miniatures from his 'Airs for the Seasons' and his *Divertimenti* for the English guitar. There is no doubt this concert should prove to be a most enjoyable voyage of musical discovery.

As always it must be emphasised that there are many other items of great musical interest to be heard in the period covered by this online edition of City Events and readers are encouraged to scan the displays in pages 15 to 24 below.
